



## Shaping Downtown's Transportation Future

### Would you like to see a streetcar, aerial tram or electric trolley bus that connects key places in and around downtown Spokane?

The City of Spokane and the Spokane Transit Authority are working together to complete The Spokane Downtown Transit Alternative Analysis to identify a high performance transit service that will connect major activity centers within the downtown core. The study area encompasses the hospitals and lower south hill to the south, the University District and east Sprague business district to the east, Browne's Addition and Peaceful Valley to the west, and the West Central, Emerson Garfield and Logan neighborhoods to the north.

The project goal is to connect major activity centers, encourage new development, improve sustainability, and increase transit mobility. We're working to compare several options such as streetcar, electric trolley bus, personal rapid transit, and others. In the end, a single preferred mode of transportation will be chosen to submit for federal funding.

## What: Public Open House

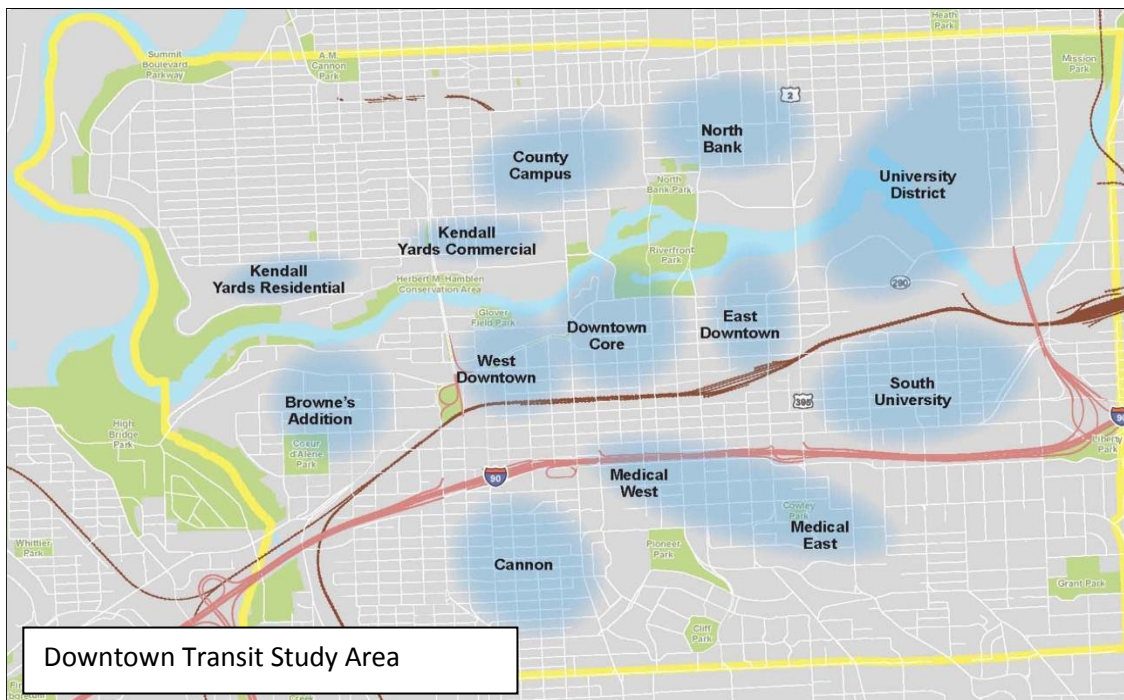
**When:** Tuesday, June 29<sup>th</sup> from 6-8pm
