When: Tuesday, June 29th from 6-8pm

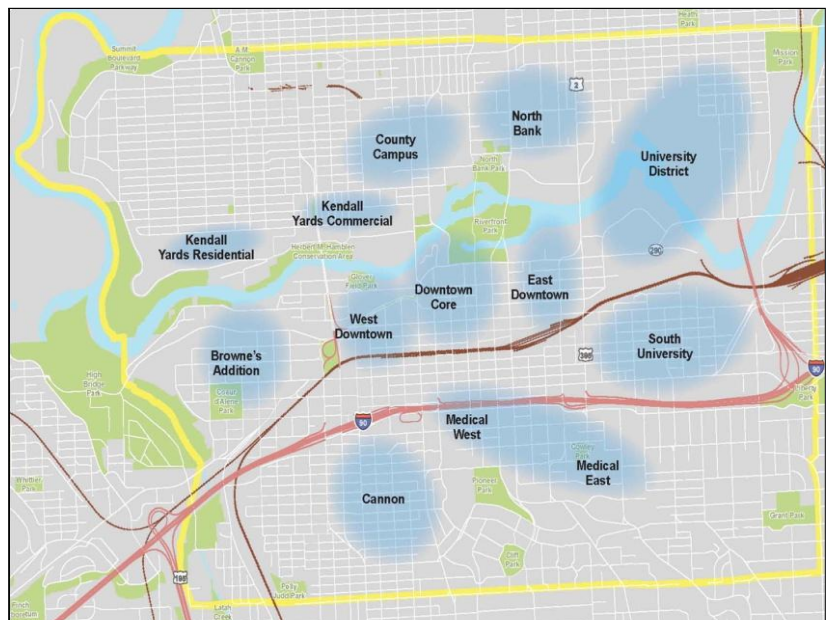
- 15 minute presentation of options at 6:15 and again at 7:00pm
